



PREPARATION AND CONFIGURATION

Expose the adhesive. Then choose flat or covered mode.

Use the product's printed reverse as the primary setup guide. Keep fingers away from the glue surface.

READ THE PRINTED REVERSE

Confirm the board is dry and undamaged. Read the printed caution and directions before removing the liner.

KEEP THE LABEL AVAILABLE

02



PEEL THE RELEASE PAPER

Hold the paper border and slowly peel the protective release sheet away. Do not press fingers into the adhesive.

REMOVE THE LINER COMPLETELY

SET FLAT ALONG A WALL

For flat use, keep the adhesive face up and place one long edge directly along an active wall-line route.

LONG EDGE FOLLOWS THE WALL

FOLD FOR COVERED USE

Fold on the printed score lines and secure as shown on the product reverse.

FOLLOW THE PRINTED REVERSE

PLACEMENT, INSPECTION AND DISPOSAL

Keep the travel line clear. Check the board every day.

For covered use, follow the orientation printed on the product reverse. Keep the adhesive dry.



COVERED-MODE PLACEMENT

Place against the wall in the orientation printed on the product reverse; keep any openings shown there unobstructed.

PLACE THE COVERED FORM

Place against the wall in the orientation printed on the product reverse; keep any openings shown there unobstructed.

FOLLOW THE PRINTED ORIENTATION

KEEP THE SETTING DRY

Avoid wet, damp, dusty or high-heat locations that can contaminate the exposed adhesive surface.

KEEP ADHESIVE UNCONTAMINATED

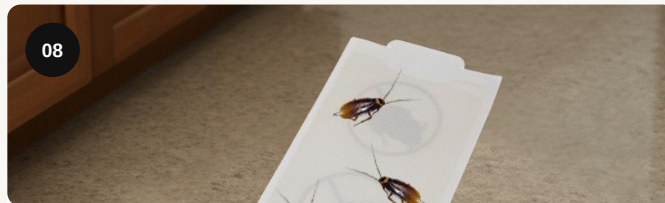


CHECK THE BOARD DAILY

Inspect every day. If a rodent is caught, follow local requirements and remove the occupied board promptly.

KEEP CHILDREN AND NON-TARGETS AWAY

USE CATCHES AS EVIDENCE

For crawling-insect monitoring, note the location and pattern of activity before removing the board.

DO NOT TOUCH THE GLUE

REASSESS THE LOCATION

If repeated checks show no activity, move the board to another dry route where signs or movement are suspected.

MOVE THE WHOLE BOARD CAREFULLY

ENCLOSE AND BAG

Wear gloves. Cover or fold the adhesive inward where practical, place the used board in a bag and dispose of it properly.

FOLLOW LOCAL DISPOSAL RULES

Accidental adhesive contact: follow the product label; vegetable oil may be used to loosen glue from skin, followed by mild soap and water.
