



OPEN & SELECT A CONFIGURATION

STEPS 01-04

PT-403PV Plastic Mice Bait Station / key-operated lid / removable lower tray / selectable approved configuration

SELECT ONE AUTHORIZED CONTROL CONFIGURATION / FOLLOW ITS LABEL, THE SITE PLAN AND REQUIRED PPE

01 CHECK THE STATION



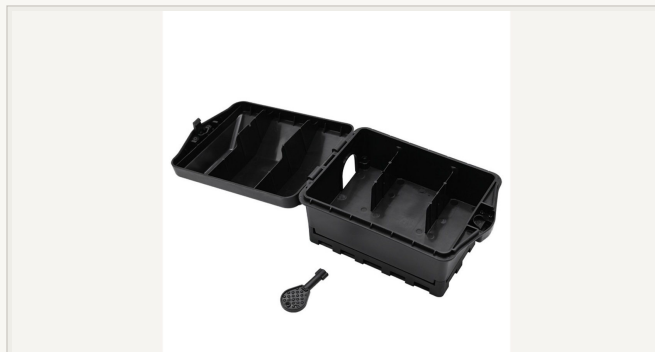
ACTION

Wear the PPE required for the selected control method. Check the housing, supplied key, lower tray and any approved optional device. Do not use cracked, distorted or incomplete parts.

KEY CHECK

Housing sound; required parts present

02 UNLOCK & OPEN



ACTION

Insert the supplied key at the lid lock, release the catch and raise the hinged roof lid without forcing it. Keep the key with authorized service personnel.

KEY CHECK

Lid opens freely; lock undamaged

03 SELECT ONE LAYOUT



ACTION

Choose one site-authorized configuration: retained bait in the upper chamber, a compatible snap trap, or a correctly sized glue board in the lower tray. Remove unrelated loose items.

KEY CHECK

One approved configuration selected

04 PULL THE LOWER TRAY



ACTION

For glue monitoring only, hold the station steady and draw the lower tray straight outward. Do not twist the tray or pull it by the station lid.

KEY CHECK

Tray slides out on its guides

CONFIGURATION DISCIPLINE

Use one approved layout at a time. A snap trap, glue board or bait setup must match the site plan and its own directions. Optional devices shown are not included unless the sales order confirms them.



ASSEMBLE, PLACE & SERVICE

STEPS 05-08

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05 FIT THE GLUE BOARD



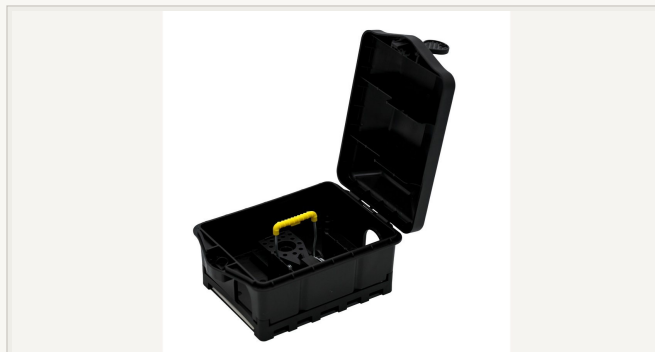
ACTION

Place only a correctly sized glue monitoring board flat in the lower tray and slide the tray fully back into the base. Follow the glue-board directions and site plan.

KEY CHECK

Board flat; tray fully seated

06 SET THE UPPER MODE



ACTION

For a compatible snap trap, seat the device flat and follow its instructions. For bait use, secure only label-authorized bait with an approved internal retention method; never leave loose bait.

KEY CHECK

Upper device stable; access path clear

07 CLOSE & LOCK



ACTION

Lower the roof lid, engage the lock with the supplied key, remove the key and confirm the lower tray is fully seated before moving or placing the station.

KEY CHECK

Lid locked; key removed; tray flush

08 PLACE & SERVICE



ACTION

Place on a stable surface as directed by the site plan with every access opening clear. Inspect and service the selected device at the interval required by its own label or instructions; relock after service.

KEY CHECK

Openings clear; service recorded

SERVICE & SAFETY

Keep the station, selected control device and service key managed as required by the relevant label, device instructions and site plan. Do not handle bait, used glue boards or captured rodents with bare hands. Keep access openings clear; remove debris and contamination safely; replace damaged parts; and lock the lid after every service. Do not describe the empty housing itself as child-safe, pet-safe, tamper-resistant or weather-resistant without the required certification.
