



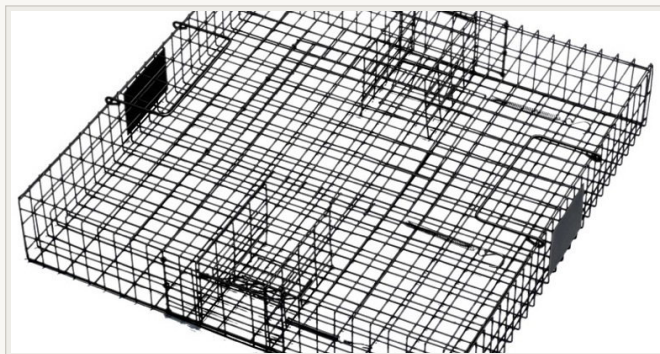
INSPECT, PREPARE & BAIT

STEPS 01-04

PT-604 / dual opposing entries / central top service door / low square-wire body

LIVE-CAPTURE DEVICE - CHECK FREQUENTLY / FOLLOW LOCAL REQUIREMENTS / KEEP CHILDREN & PETS AWAY

01 CHECK THE EMPTY TRAP



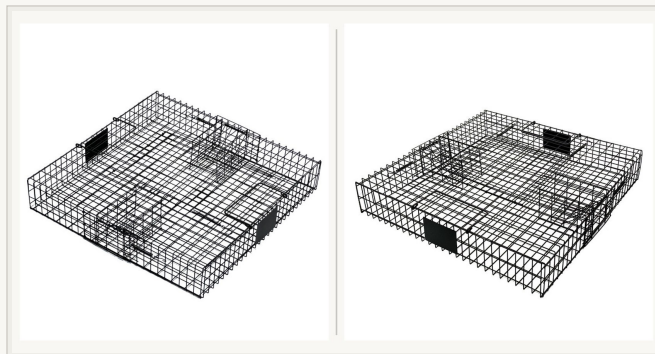
ACTION

Wear work gloves. Confirm the wire body, central top door, both opposing entry assemblies and their fitted retainers are present, clean and undamaged.

KEY CHECK

Body sound; doors and retainers present

02 INSPECT BOTH ENTRIES



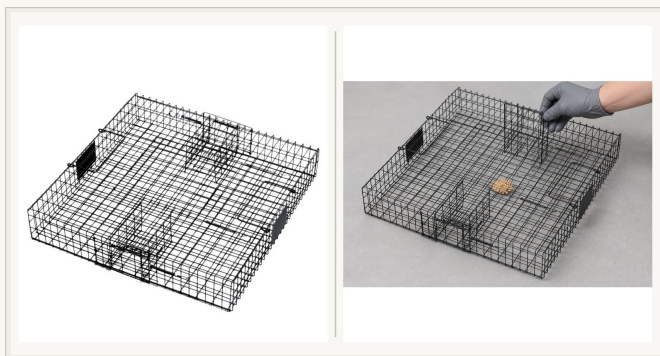
ACTION

Locate the two opposing entry assemblies. Visually inspect each outer plate, inner flap, fitted spring or retainer and surrounding wire for distortion, debris or missing parts; do not bend the wire.

KEY CHECK

Two entries present, clear and undamaged

03 OPEN & BAIT THE CENTRE



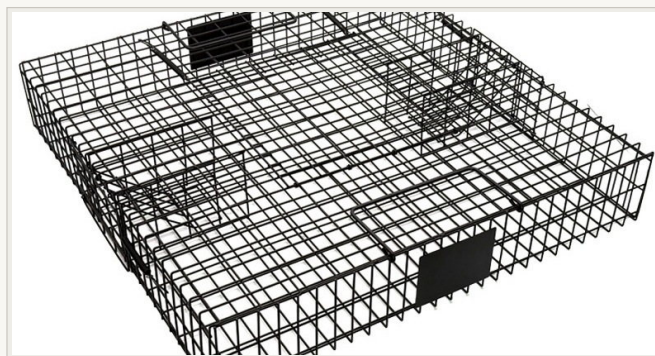
ACTION

Open the central top service door. Put a small amount of suitable food bait on the flat centre floor, clear of both entry assemblies; do not add a plate or loose hardware.

KEY CHECK

Bait centred; entry paths clear

04 CLOSE THE TOP ACCESS

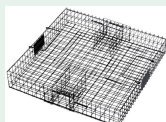


ACTION

Lower the top service door and fully engage its existing wire retainer. Check that no bait or debris is caught in the closing edge.

KEY CHECK

Top door closed and retained



STRUCTURE CHECK / PT-604

dual opposing entries / central top service door / low square-wire body

Stop if the body, door, trigger, entry flap, linkage, latch or retainer required for this model is missing, distorted or damaged.



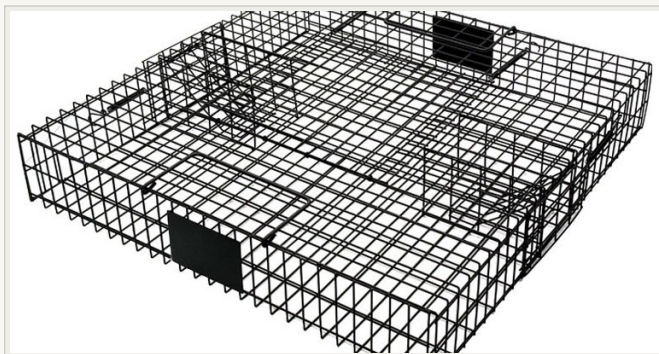
PLACE, CHECK & SERVICE

STEPS 05-08

PT-604 / dual opposing entries / central top service door / low square-wire body

LIVE-CAPTURE DEVICE - CHECK FREQUENTLY / FOLLOW LOCAL REQUIREMENTS / KEEP CHILDREN & PETS AWAY

05 PLACE FLAT & LEVEL



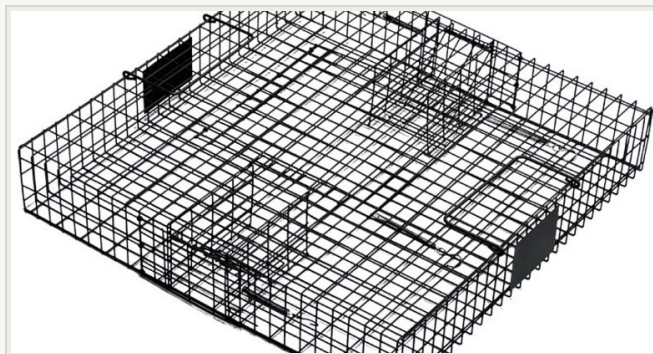
ACTION

Set the closed trap flat on a dry, stable surface where activity has been observed. Keep both opposing entry approaches open and unobstructed.

KEY CHECK

Level base; two clear approaches

06 CHECK FREQUENTLY



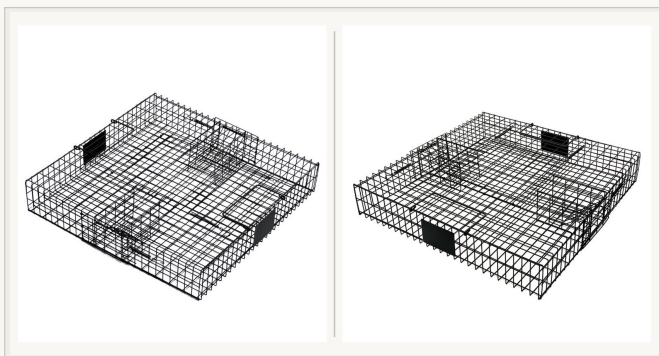
ACTION

Inspect the trap frequently and more often in heat, cold or other stressful conditions. Keep children, pets and non-target animals away.

KEY CHECK

Condition checked and recorded

07 VERIFY BEFORE MOVING



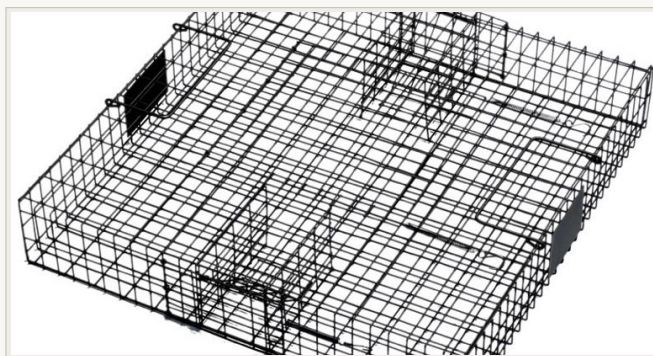
ACTION

Before moving an occupied trap, verify that both entry assemblies are closed and each fitted retainer remains present and in its required position under the site handling procedure. Keep the trap level.

KEY CHECK

Entries closed; retainers verified

08 RESET OR STORE



ACTION

After authorized handling and only when the trap is empty, remove debris, wash if required and dry fully. Close the top door, confirm both entries and retainers, then reset or store dry.

KEY CHECK

Empty, clean, closed and dry

HANDLING & SERVICE

Choose bait, placement and inspection frequency for the target and site. Follow applicable local wildlife, animal-control and release requirements. Avoid direct contact with captured animals or contaminated material. Keep the device sheltered from severe heat, cold and weather where practical. After every use, confirm the trap is empty, clean and dry before resetting or storage.
